A maximum number of three presentations from each university will be permitted at the conference. The three presenters should be delegated by the CIB Student Chapters. If three presentations are given, it is recommended that students, Ph.D. students and young teachers each present on a different topic.

Participation at the conference is free of charge for the presenters. Travel and accommodation costs are not included.

Presenters should submit the abstract of their presentation by 15 February 2010. Abstracts will be published in the abstract book of the conference.
