Introduction

The National Hungarian CIB Student Chapter – with the support of the CIB Board – is delighted to invite you to take part in the International CIB Student Chapter Conference 2010, which takes place in Budapest, Hungary on 30 September – 2 October 2010. Students, Ph.D. students and young teachers of construction higher education are welcome to present their research topics at the conference.

Conference Themes

The conference themes are:

- Liveable city
- Environmentally conscious, energy efficient building
- Architectural culture Architectural renewal and preservation
- Other topics

Conference language: English

Participants: students, Ph.D. students, young teachers. Presentations should be no longer than 15 minutes. In addition to the scientific programme, social programmes will also be offered.

A maximum of three presentations from each university will be permitted at the conference. The three presenters should be delegated by the CIB Student Chapter at each University. If three presentations are given,

it is recommended that students, Ph.D. students and young teachers each present on a different topic.

Participation at the conference is free of charge for the presenters. Travel and accommodation costs are not included.

Call for Abstracts

Presenters should submit the abstract of their presentation by 15 February 2010. Abstracts will be published in the abstract book of the conference.
