Invitation for Proposals 2007

The winning proposal will receive financial support in the magnitude of Euro 3500. In addition the CIB Secretariat will provide administrative and other types of support for its execution as much as practically possible.

Proposals will be assessed on the magnitude of contributions to be expected from the proposed activities to:

- promote CIB and its objectives
- stimulate and facilitate exchange and information between existing CIB Endorsed Student Chapters
- attract new CIB Endorsed Student Chapters
- stimulate and facilitate cooperation between research activities as carried out by students and staff related to CIB Endorsed Student Chapters

In case of proposals that focus on certain R&D themes, a linkage is recommended to the defined CIB Priority Themes: Sustainable Construction, Clients and Users

in Construction, Revaluing Construction and Integrated Design Solutions.
