Hungarian CIB Student Chapter Conference

Budapest, Hungary, 27 March 2009

The Hungarian national CIB Student Chapter held its national student conference on 27 March 2009 where Dr. Wim Bakens, CIB Secretary General was also invited and took part, much to the delight of the organisers and participants. The conference took place in EMI (Non-profit Company for Quality Control and Innovation in Building) in Budapest, Hungary. The language of the conference was English.



Dr. Tamás Bánky, EMI Scientific Director opened the meeting, welcomed students and colleagues, and provided information on the timing of the day. A special welcome was addressed to Dr. Wim Bakens, CIB Secretary General.

Melinda Kozák, EMI Project Manager gave a presentation on the Hungarian CIB Student Chapter. The Hungarian CIB Student Chapter is a national Student Chapter, consists of 1 old and 4 new CIB members (university faculties), the members are in 4 different cities of Hungary. It was established at the end of 2007, this conference is its 5th meeting. EMI provides national coordination and helps in communication with CIB.

Dr. Wim Bakens showed the newest CIB presentation on DVD and reported recent CIB news.

Each Hungarian Student Chapter member faculty could delegate one or two students to this conference, finally students from 4 university faculties took part at the conference. Students held 15 minute long lectures on different research topics, the lectures were excellent and well-prepared. All together 6 lectures were presented which are the following:

- Miklós Oroszlány: Reused and recycled building materials
- Eszter Papp - József Élő - Roland Lipusz - Péter Schmidt: Concurrence of culture, nature and technology at the waterfront of Győr
- Katalin Kiss - Tamás Asztalos: Analyzing sewer systems by dynamic runoff modelling
- Ágota Vili: Interactive architecture
- Dóra Bácsalmásy - Vera Mikuli: The present, past and future of folk architecture in Drávaszög



After the presentations and discussions Dr. Tamás Bánky closed the meeting by thanking students and their tutors for the excellent lectures and Dr. Wim Bakens for all useful and edifying information.

2010 International Student Conference

The Hungarian CIB Student Chapter decided to organise a 2-3 day long international conference next year in Hungary, with the participation of Student Chapters in other universities.
