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## WHAT'S NEW?

The Build Your English application is almost done. The project partnership plans to conduct BYE workshops and test courses during December 2013 and January 2014.





Workshops will be a great opportunity to present to potential users of the BYE application, and give invited persons the opportunity to participate in test trainings. They will evaluate the prepared programme on the basis of an evaluation questionnaire.

In addition, we would like to check if the BYE application contributes to the acquisition of greater knowledge of technical English language. In order to do this each participant must fill in two identical tests - one before starting work on the application and one upon completion of the use of the application.

These three forms will be given to the participants during the workshops. There will be the possibility to join test courses via the internet. Mailing will be done to potential beneficiaries in each partner country.

# **BUILD YOUR ENGLISH SOFTWARE**

The BUILD YOUR ENGLISH software has been developed and it looks perfect ②. After almost two years, it has been developed as a transparent English learning tool. The application was developed according to the potential beneficiaries' needs. The reliable Build Your English software allows access to the Build Your English application through a user-friendly layout.

Additional options such as a glossary, instruction movies, grammar tips, additional exercises for teachers and quizzes were added to the programme contents.
